COVID update

Thank you to parents and families for your continued support with **pick-up/drop-off routines**. It is important that adults coming onto site before and after school continue to social distance and do not enter classrooms unless by appointment.

Acquaintance night this coming Tuesday 9 February, between 5.30 and 6.30pm, will provide a valuable opportunity for parents/caregivers to enter learning spaces. We kindly ask all attending to support our teachers by adhering to the maximum room occupancy signs that will be displayed at all classroom doors. Hand sanitisation stations will be positioned around the school and all visitors will need to sign in once upon entry using the QR code (or at front office for those without a mySAGOV app on their phone), as per Health SA guidelines. There will be no formal presentations from staff and no catering. Families will be able to arrive and move between learning spaces at their leisure during the hour.

Our 2021 Student Ambassadors all participated in an introductory session with leadership staff on Wednesday.
