Return to school

Well done to all students, staff and families for the patient and agile manner in which you have all negotiated the adjusted return to school. I am pleased to report that our new reception students who commenced face to face learning this week have all settled in well and are wearing our school uniform with great pride and energy! All students will recommence face-to-face learning on Monday 14 February (Week 3) - in the meantime, Year 2-6 teachers will continue to provide at home learning programs via Seesaw and we will support any students who cannot be cared for at home here at school. Year 2-6 students who attend school during this period are being supervised by Specialist Teachers, Leadership and Temporary Relief Teachers in three class/year level groups, in Rooms 3 and 4 and our old Resource Centre. Class teachers are focusing on supporting students learning at home and are not expected to deliver remote and face to face learning at the same time.

Staff movement & welcomes

We warmly welcome two new staff members to our school this year, Alex O'Reilly and Georgia Knight. We stole Alex from Glenelg Primary School where she has taught Junior Primary for the past 6 years and her experience, energy and personable nature is already proving to be a real asset to our staff and school community. Alex is teaching Year 1s in Room 16. Georgia Knight has also commenced in an on-going administrative assistant role, working with Jo and Marcia in our front office. Like Alex, Georgia comes highly recommended and has already made a significant impact with her friendly and efficient approach to what has been a very challenging start to the school year.

Paul Sawyer will be on long service leave from weeks 3-5 this term, with Dena Duthoit stepping into the Specialist Health and PE position while he is away. Dena has worked at our school for a number of years in various contract and TRT roles and also works in our Out of School Hours Care (OSHC) service on a regular basis and knows our students and school community well.

Building works update

The concept for our new building project has now passed the 90% costing stage, with plans expected to be finalised and sent to the Department for review for approval in the coming weeks. The project team met on Thursday to review interior layouts and colour selections and the end result is going to be fantastic (see indicative images of admin and resource centre facades below). Our Governing Council have also approved a school-funded upgrade of our bitumen court area as an adjunct to the project, which will include new basketball/netball rings and line marking in our internal courtyard area.
